■ The Massachusetts Turnpike Authority is refusing to release financial details of its deal to redevelop the former Big Dig headquarters site off Kneeland Street. Boston Residential, which has proposed an 800-foot condominium tower for the so-called South Bay site, was the only bidder for the project. Turnpike officials have said they hope to generate between \$100 million and \$200 million from the deal.
