... The Boston Herald last October described Curtis Kemeny '84, president and CEO of the Boston Residential Group, as "a developer fast gaining the reputation for bold moves." Kemeny purchased the Red Cross building in Boston's South End last November for a planned condo/retail space, and his conversion of upper floor offices into luxury, loft-style condos in the former Tower Records building was featured in both the Herald and The Boston Globe last fall. The landmark Back Bay building underwent a famous Frank Gehry redesign in 1987, a renovation that Kemeny worked on as a young real-estate project manager.
